कार्यक्रम अपेक्षाओं पर निर्भर करते हुए प्रसारित किए जाते हैं। तथापि, दिल्ली दूरवर्शन केन्द्र सप्ताह के हर शुक्रवार को राज्दीय नेटवर्क के प्रपने प्रातःकालीन प्रसारण में नियमित रूप से 15 मिनट का संस्कृत में एक कार्यक्रम प्रसारित कर रहा है। इसके अलावा, कभी-कभी विशिष्ट ग्रवसरों जैसे कालीदास महोत्सव ग्रीर महर्षि बाल्मिकि जयंती पर संस्कृत कार्यक्रम प्रसारित किए जाते हैं।

Incentive package in Kashmir

254. SHRI MURLIDHAR CHANDRA-KANT BHANDARE: Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government's attention has been drawn to the report that appeared in the Economic Times of January 22, 1991 captioned 'Incentive Package in Kashmir Fails':
 - (b) what are the details thereof;
- (c) what amends if any are being made in the Incentive scheme to achieve the objective in the light of the said report; and
- (d) what are the causes of the failure of the scheme according to the report and what is Government's reaction thereto?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS AND THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING (SHRI SUBODH KANT SAHAY): (a) to (d) Deatils are awaited from the Government of Jammu & Kashmir.

Activities of Tamil militants in Tamil Nadu

255, SHRI MURLIDHAR CHANDRA-KANT BHANDARE: Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that activities of Tamil militants from Sri Lanka, including LITE militants have taken a serious turn especially during the second half of 1990 and in 1991 so far; and

(b) if so, what steps have been taken to tackle the law and order there?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MENISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS AND THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING (SHRI SUBODH KANT SAHAY): (a) The available reports indicate that the Sri Lankan Tamil Militants engaged themselves in a number of illegal activities in Tamil Nadu during the period in question.

(b) The Government of Tamil Nadu has reported that police action against the militants has been intensified. Strictly, vigilance along the coastal areas is being maintained by deploying para military forces along the coastal area, which are supplemented by mobile and foot patrolling. The State Government is maintaining close coordination with Navy, Coast Guard and other Central agencies to curb the militants' activities in the State.

Socialistic measures in Public Sector Undertakings

256. SHRI MURLIDHAR CHANDRA-KANT BHANDARE: Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government have been considering certain socialistic measures, including voluntary sacrifice by the rich changes in administration of public sector enterprises to yield Rs. 5000/- crores in the short run; and
- (b) if so what decisions have been taken in this regard?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE PRIME MINISTER'S OFFICE (SHRI KAMAL MORARKA): (a) and (b) No measures as stated have been considered by the Government. However, a rough calculation indicates that a 5 per cent improvement in performance of the Central Public Sector Enterprises will yield 5,000 crores per annum. It is a policy of the Government to improve performance of the Central Public Sector Enterprises.
