

One-rank one-pension for ex-servicemen

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF DEFENCE (SHRI LALIT VIJAY SINGH): (a) to (c) The Committee on 'One Rank One Pension' considered all aspects of the issue but was unable to arrive at a consensus. Thereafter, discussions were held with the various concerned Departments/Ministries and a Scheme to provide an ad-hoc increase in pensions to Defence personnel, below officer level, who retired before 1-1-1986, was approved by the previous Government on 1st November 1990. This decision is being reviewed by the present Government.
