(c) The Administrator of the Union Territory of Delhi is appointed by the President. The appointment of the Chief Secretary and the Police Commissioner is done by the competent authority after due considerations.

Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that a number of bomb blasts took place in Delhi in January, 1991 particularly near Tis Hazari Court, near the Police Head Quarters, inside a cinema hall in Chandni Chowk and at Janpath;

(b) if so, details of the damage caused to buildings and other properties and the number of persons injured and killed in these incidents;

(c) whether any compensation has been paid to the victims;

(d) whether any enquiry has been conducted in each case and whether any arrests have been made;

(e) whether a 'red alert' is continuously kept up in Delhi, particularly, in sensitive areas, to prevent such incidents in time;

(f) the details of the security steps being taken in the light of part (a) above; and

(g) the number of bomb explosions that have occurred in the capital and the cases solved?
