

Production of drugs whose contents are imported

1645. SHRI ANANT RAM JAISWAL: Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

(a) what are the names of drugs being produced in the country whose import contents are more than 33 per cent of the CIF value of import of each drug;

(b) what is the stage from which each is being produced;

(c) what are the names of the producers and what was fine production of each during the last three years, year-wise; and

(d) what are the names of drugs which are exempted from price control?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS (DR. CHINTA, MOHAN); (a) to (d) Import content in respect of each drug depends upon various factors such as international price of imported raw materials and intermediates, exchange rate of the rupee etc. Since the above factors, as well as the CIF value of the drug, are dynamic in nature, the percentage of import content also varies. There are over 300 bulk drugs which are being manufactured indigenously and it is not practically possible to monitor the data asked for in respect of each drug continuously.

Details of production of these drugs are not monitored by this Ministry.

Therefore, taking into consideration such factors as well as the need firen-couraging indigenous manufacture from more basic stages, level of indigenous technology available etc. Government has prescribed basic stages for the manufacture of bulk drugs. Approvals for bulk drugs are being given from these stages.

(a) what are the names of anti-cancer drugs which are being produced in the country;

(b) what are names of producers and what was the production of each during 1990-91;

(c) what are the names of drugs allowed for import and what was the import during 1990-91 quantity-wise and value-wise; and

(d) what are the names of drugs which are exempted from customs duty?

(d) Anticancer fodmulations listed in appednix 6 list 3 are exempted from customs duty. Some important anticancer bulk drugs which are also exempted from customs duty are given in the statement attached.
