Terrorist attacks in Jammu and Kashmir

*403. SHRIMATI S.G. INDIRA: Will the Minister of DEFENCE be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of Indian Army officers in the rank of Major and above killed in different terrorist related attacks during the last three months in Jammu and Kashmir; and
- (b) the steps proposed to be taken by Government to minimise these casualties?

THE MINISTER OF DEFENCE (SHRI GEORGE FERNANDES): (a) 3 Army Officers of the rank of Major and above were killed in terrorist actions in J&K during the last three months *i.e.* from 1st September to 30th November, 2001.

(b) Appropriate measures are being taken by the Army to minimize casualties incurred during operations in J&K. These measures include, extensive orientation training of newly inducted units/personnel for effective performance in the prevailing operational environment, constant fine tuning of tactical drills and procedures ensuring optimal safety, and emphasis on the use of personal protection equipment.
