in money supply, effect economy in Government expenditure, encourage small savings, ensure better supply and demand management of sensitive commodities, strengthening of the public distribution system and provision of incentives for higher production in the medium term. With a view to closely monitoring the prices of the essential commodities and ensuring their supply the Government has constituted recently a Cabinet Committee on Prices under the Chairmanship of the Union Minister for Finance. It is expected that all these measures will help in sobering the price behaviour in the coming months.

KURIEN): (a) to (c) According to the Index of Industrial Production compiled by CSO Central Statistical Organisation the overall rate of industrial growth was 8.4 per cent during 1990-91 which was almost at the same level as that achieved in the last financial year

The Eighth Five Year Plan document is not yet finalised and as such the yearly targeted rate of indus trial growth is not available.
