PLIES AND PUBLIC DISTRIBU-TION (SHRI KAMALUDDIN' AHMED): (a) The strengthening and streamlining of the Public Distribution System (PDS) is a continual process. There exists a joint responsibility between the Central Government and the Governments of the States and UTs. While the Central Government is responsible for procurement, storage and transportation of key essential commodities upto central godowns, its further distribution to consumers through the network of Fair Price Shops (FPS) is administered by the State Governments/UT Administrations. Central Government has been advising them, from time to time, among other things, to increase coverage of the population by opening new FPSs, in uncovered/undercovered areas. to issue ration cards to all families, use vans as mobile outlets wherever necessary in far flung, hilly and remote areas; increase commodity **Coverage** by adding. on their own. additional items of mass consumption,

(b) An estimated population of about 72.9 crores was covered as on 31st December, 1989, through the ration cards issued by State Governments/UT Administrations.

## **Commissioning a TV Relay Station at** Allahabad

343. SHRI SATYA PRAKASH MALAVIYA: Will the Minister ി INFORMATION AND BROADCAST-ING be pleased to state:

(a) what progress has been made with regard to the commissioning of a T.V. Relay Station at Allahabad; and

(b) by when it is likely to be commissioned and reasons for delay?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING (KUM. GIRIJA VYAS): (a) and (b) A high power (10 KW) **T.V**. Transmitter has already been functioning at Allahabad since August, 1983. A TV Studio Centre is also envisaged to be set up at Allahabad, as a spill-over scheme from the Seventh Plan. Site for this project has been finalised and orders for part equipment placed on the manufacturers. The normal lead time involved in the completion of a project of this magnitude is about 4 years from the date of formal approval of the scheme by the Government.
