SOURCES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Delhi Electric Supply Undertaking has extended its ban orders on air conditioners and neon signs; and
- (b) if so, what is the estimate of saving of power by this step?

THE MINISTER OF STATE (IN-THE DEPENDENT CHARGE) OF MINISTRY OF POWER AND NON-CONVENTIONAL ENERGY SOUR-CES (SHRI KALP NATH RAI): (a) and (b) The ban imposed by Delhi Administration on the use of air-conditioners and neon signs from 6.30 P.M. to 10 P.M. under Clause 4(11) of the Delhi Electricity Control Orders 1959 is already force. While, it is not possible to quantify the exact savings in power due to the restrictions on the use of air-conditioners/neon-signs, helped DESU to improve and stabilise the power supply system.

Against this requirement 4.24 million tonnes of coal was supplied by the coal companies to **MSEB** during April-June, 1991. The Standing Linkage Committee has fixed a linkage of 5.64 million tonnes of coal for the

for quarter July-September, 1991 The MSEB thermal power stations. Standing Linkage Committee will decide the allocations for October-December, 1991 in September, and for January-March, 1992 in December for MSEB after taking into account its requirements, availability and transport infrastructure other and competing demands from consumers.
