

Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes on these Boards?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRI DALBIR SINGH): (a) and (b) The Board of Directors of the nationalised banks is a continuing entity and vacancies of directors that arise are filled up from time to time. At present 99 non official directors are in position on the boards of nationalised banks and there are 81 vacancies. The Boards of Directors of 12 nationalised banks have one director each belonging to SC/ST.

**Cracks in STC building at Tolstoy Marg, New Delhi**

1181. SHRI PRAKASH YASHWANT AMBEDKAR: Will the Minister of COMMERCE be pleased to state:

(a) whether the State Trading Corporation building at Tolstoy Marg, New Delhi has developed any crack on the first three floors;

(b) if so, whether the building is still safe as office premises;

(c) what was the total cost of the building; and

(d) what action Government propose to take in the matter?

THE MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) OF THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE (SHRI P. CHIDAMBARAM): (a) Based on the review of the structural design of the building, M/s. Engineers India Ltd. and the Indian Institute of Technology, Delhi had indicated the following defects which have since been rectified:—

(i) Some ribs on 2nd and 3rd floors were inadequately reinforced due to premature curtailment of bottom reinforcement;

(ii) Some of the main ribs on lower floors (Upper ground floor

and First floor) were inadequately reinforced to carry shear around the cutouts for ducts etc.

(b) Yes, Sir.

(c) and (d) The total cost of the building excluding land cost as on 31.3.91 works out to Rs. 28.99 crores. It does not include contingent liabilities amounting to Rs. 7.56 crores under arbitration.
