

Relief Supplies for earthquake victims in U.S.S.R.

@1373—F. SHRI S. MADHAVAN: Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

(a) whether the attention of Government was drawn to the news item published in the daily "The Hindu" dated 26-6-1991 relating to the relief materials intended for helping earthquake victims in Armenia in U.S.S.R. lying dumped and uncared for in the Indian Red Cross Society; and

(b) if so, what actions are taken to send those relief materials?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SMT. D. K. THARA DEVI SIDDHARTHA): (a) and (b) Yes, Sir. The news item was published in "The Hindu" dated 20-6-1991. The Indian Red Cross Society has intimated that after the earthquake on 8-12-1988, relief supplies consisting of blankets, stretchers, medical/surgical equipment were transported in four flights between 9th to 26th December, 1988. Both the Government of USSR and Soviet Red Cross were requested to indicate the additional needs so that the item could be despatched on priority. No further request was received by the Indian Red Cross Society. Meanwhile, the Indian Red Cross Society, continued to receive gifts upto mid-March, 1989 for the victims of the Armenian earthquake from various agencies of Government and private industry. The Indian Red Cross Society has taken up the disposal/utilisation of the items in stock in consultation with the Ministry of External Affairs.
