

Madurai Section of NH-49, a provision has been made in the Annual Plan 1990-91 for making up works amounting to Rs. 630 lakhs. Against this, one work costing Rs. 19.35 lakhs has already been sanctioned. Other estimates and proposals are still awaited from the State Governments. The expenditure on the sanctioned development works will be met out of allocation of Rs. 2,600 lakhs and Rs. 1,650 lakhs earmarked, respectively, for the States of Tamil Nadu and Kerala during the current financial year.

(b) and (c) The road section is generally in a traffic worthy condition and necessary repairs are being carried out by the respective State Government out of maintenance and repair funds for National Highway placed at their disposal. Since, February, 1989, an expenditure of Rs. 110 lakhs is reported to have been incurred by the State PWDs on maintenance of this section, as per latest figures available.

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF PETROLEUM AND CHEMICALS AND THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI JAI PRAKASH): (a) and (b) The Government has set up a High Level Committee to go into all aspects of restructuring of Telecom Department, including Madras Telephones, and to recommend the most appropriate organisational structure keeping in view the developmental and operational needs as

well as the financial implications etc. Appropriate decisions in the matter will be taken after the receipt of the Committee's Report.

Financing of East Coast road project by A.D.B.

THE MINISTER OF WATER RESOURCES WITH ADDITIONAL CHARGE OF THE MINISTRY OF SURFACE TRANSPORT (SHRI MANUBHAI KOTADIA): (a) to (d) Yes, Sir, Asian Development Bank has agreed to partly finance development of a section of East Coast Road in Tamil Nadu in a length of about 160 km at an estimated cost of Rs. 5400 crores. The project is proposed to be completed in four years time after award of the work which is yet to be done by Tamil Nadu Government.
