The first unit of 500 MW of the proposed Visakhapatnam Thermal Power Project is generally commissioned after 60 months from the date of placement of orders for the main plant and equipment. As Tegards Godavari Combined Cycle Gas Turbine Project the commissioning Schedule will be dependent on configuration of the unit size of the gas based plant which is yet to be determined as the scheme is tentatively included for yielding benefits during the Eighth Plan which is under finalisation.

Fire in Hydro Power Station at Kadambari, Madras
