THE MINISTER OF WATER RE SOURCES WITH ADDITIONAL CHARGE OF THE MINISTRY OF SURFACE TRANSPORT (SHRI MANUBHAI KOTADIA): (a) to (d) The proposals for the Vill Five "Sear Plan for creating additional irrigation facilities have not yet been finalised. However the additional irrigation potential that would be created during Vill Plan through ongoing and new schemes, would benefit the dry land areas in Madhya Pradesh also. In the Vill Plan, thrust will remain on completion of ongoing schemes.

Emergency Food Aid to the Soviet Union

763. SHRI G. G. SWELL; Will the Minister of EXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether India have rushed emergency food aid to the Soviet Union;

(b) the amount of food delivered and the break-up of items; and

(c) whether the quantity of food that the Soviet Union. will need has been assessed and if so, over what period?

THE MINISTER OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI VIDYA CHARAN SHUKLA): (a) Yes, sir.

(b) Government have decided to provide USSR one million tonnes of wheat on a loan basis, as well as a gift of 20, 000 tonnes of rice and othp essential items such as medicines, medical supplies and processed food items. The first consignment consisting of medicine and food items has been sent by a special flight 021 27th Dec' tuber, 1990.

(c) According to Soviet estimates,, additional imports of Roubles 10 billion would be required in 1991 to tide over the present shortages.
