(a) whether it is a fact that there is a great need for starting Speed-Post service to Nagarcoil, an important trade and business centre in Kanyakumari District; and

(b) if so, the steps taken to start this service as a priority basis?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF PETROLEUM AND CHEMICALS AND THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI JAI PARKASH): (a) No, Sir, there is no traffic potential at Nagarcoil for introduction speed post service in the city.

**Trade amongst SAARC Countries**

725. SHRI VIREN J. SHAH:

SHRI SHANKAR DAYAL SINGH:

Will the Minister of EXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government's attention has been drawn to the study conducted by the Research and Information System for the Non-Aligned and other Developing Countries (RIS), which appeared in 'Business and Political Observer' of 6th December, 1990, especially on the observation that expansion of trade among SAARC countries has more profound economic basis than achievement of regional self-reliance;

(b) whether it is a fact that unit values realised by SAARC countries in their exports to regional countries are higher than those to the rest of the World, especially for goods where freight cost is significant;

(c) if so, whether Government would consider the proposal of providing special measures for Intra-SAARC trade in consultation with other countries to substantially increase Intra-SAARC trade accounts from the present level of a mere 2.5 per cent of the total trade of these countries; and

(d) if not, what are the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI VIDYA CHARAN SHUKLA): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) This is one of the conclusions of the RIS study.

(c) The Government is prepared to consider any proposal for special measures for substantially expanding intra-SAARC trade.

(d) Does not arise.
