THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE PRIME MINISTER'S OFFICE (SHRI KAMAL MORARKA): The production of cigarettes in the organised sector during the last three years is estimated as under: —

(a) whether Government's attention has been drawn to the Human Rights Group's various reports such as 'India Kashmir wars'; 'Kashmir imprisoned'; PUCL and Citizens for Democracy report and Human Rights Protection Body, Srinagar report etc.;

(b) what are the facts in regard to the various incidents and comments made in the aforesaid reports;

(c) whether Government have constituted an inquiry in regard to these incidents; and

(d) if so, the results thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS AND THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING (SHRI SUBODH KANT SAHAY): (a) to (d) The Authors of the reports of "Independent Initiative" have not been mentioned in the question. Some organisations have sent their representatives to Kashmir and copies of their reports have been sent to the State Govt, for comments.

#### **Low power TV transmitters in Tjttar Pradesh**

1477. SHRI KAPIL VERMA: Will PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

(a) what is the number of low power TV transmitters likely to be installed in Uttar Pradesh during the year 1990-91; and

(b) whether there is any proposal under Government's consideration to convert or instal a high power transmitter in the State during the year 1990-91?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS AND THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING (SHRI SUBODH KANT SAHAY): (a) Whereas one Low Power (100W) TV transmitter has already been commissioned, a very low power (2x10W) TV transmitter and a TV transposer are also expected to be commissioned into service in Uttar Pradesh during 1990-91.

(b) No, Sir. However the establishment of a high power (10KW) TV transmitter and Programme Generation Facility (PGF) Centre under implementation at Bareilly is expected to be commissioned into service during 1991-92.
