Pak attack in Keran sub-section of Jammu and Kashmir

1434. SHRI MURLIDHAR CHAN-DRAKANT BHANDARE Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that Pakistani forces resorted to unprovoked attack with mortar and heavy artillery in the Keran sub-sector in Jammu and Kashmir on October, 4, 1990 and that the

Indian troops repulsed the attack effectively:

- (c) whether the Pak attack was aimed at pushing trained terrorists with arms across the borders into Punish and how far their object was fulfilled?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY \mathbf{OF} DEFENCE LALIT VIJAY SINGH): (a) and (b) Pakistan had resorted to unprovoked firing with mortar and heavy artillery in the Keran Sector on 4-10-1990, in which three of our personnel were wounded. Fire was effectively returned. Casualties suffered by the Pakistanis are not known.

(c) There have been occasions when the Pak troops were giving fire cover to the Pak trained militants returning the Indian side of the Line of Control. Such firing had to be effectively returned by the Indian troops, to foil such attempts.
