Effect on tourism and hotel industry in Delhi due to anti-reservation and Ram .Sanam Bhoomi-Babri Masjid issue

180. SHRI V. NARAYANASAMY: Will the Minister of TOURISM be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that Tourism and Hotel industry in Delhi have been affected because of the disturbances over anti-reservation stir and Ram Janam Bhoomi-Babri Masjid issues in north India; and

(b) whether Government are taking any steps to improve the Tourism prospects for national and international tourists in the coming years?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF TOURISM (SHRIMATI USHA SINGH): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) The steps being taken for improving the prospects of national and international tourists include continued *augmentation* of infra-structural facilities, diversification of tourist attractions, removal of irritants to international tourists and publicity of tourism facilities in India. Fire in the Kakatiya fast Passenger train

(a) whether a large number of persons were burnt to death following a fire in a compartment of the Kakatiya fast *passenger* train bound for Warangal recently;

(b) if so, the number of persons who were killed in the fire-

(c) the total loss of property due to the fire;

(d) the causes of the fire incident;

(e) what is the result of the inquiry conducted by Government into that fire incident; and

(f) what action has been taken by Government in the matter?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI BHAKTA CHARAN DAS): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) 48.

(c) Rs. 2.30 lakhs approximately.

(d) and (e) According to the inquiry conducted by the Commissioner of Railway Safety, South Central Circle, the fire occurred due to an act of arson by unknown persons.

(f) The train is being escorted after the incident.
