(a) and (b) The Central issue prices (ex-FCI godowns) of rice and wheat are revised from time to time consequent to increase in the support prices of paddy and wheat The prevailing Central issue price of wheat is Rs 234 per quintal effective from 1st May, 1990 and in case of rice, it is Rs 289, Rs 349 and Rs 370 per quintal for common, fine and superfine varieties respectively effective from 25th June, 1990

The retail issue price of sugar supplied under public listribution system was last increased from Rs 510 to Rs 525 per kg. we f 1-1-1989
