MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE VIRCHAND-(SHRI JAYANTILAL BHAI SHAH), (a) and (b) Considering the dangers of health hazards and poisoning due to improper usage of pesticides and other accidental incidence, the Government are emphsasing on safe and judicious use of chemical pesticides The Government are also encouraging the adoption of biological control for pest control in agriculture Similarly, the Government is also supporting the use of biol-fertilizers and organic manures for supplementing the use of chemical fertilizers

The Government are proposing to undertake an expanded programme of Integrated Pest Management including biological control during the VIIIth Five Year Plan and is placing high emphasis on this programme

- (c) Based on the research investigations conducted, some of the 1mportant publications like
 - (1) Problems and prospects Botanical Pesticides in Integrated Pest Management: and
 - (ii) Biological control on identified crop pests have been published
- (d) At present, biol control agents are being introduced and distributed by 11 Central Biological Control Stations set up by the Government of India in different parts of the coun-Some smaller units have also been set up by a few State Govern-One private company is also selling these agents on commercial However, the Government are proposing to expind these in the Government sector and also encouraging public and private sector companies to undertake their production and sale
