Darbhanga-Farbishganj Highway

1386. SHRIMATI KAMLA STNHA:
Will the Minister of SURFACE
TRANSPORT be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that Darbhanga-Farbishganj Highway was to be incorporated as National Highway in the Eighth Five Year Plan; and

(b) if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) OF THE MINISTRY OF SURFACE TRANSPORT (SHRI JAGDISH TYTLER): (a) and (b) The question of declaration of new National Highways in various States including the road in question in Bihar can be taken up only after formulation of the 8th Five Year Plan, subject to availability of resources, recommendations made by the N.T.P.C. (National Transport Policy Committee), *inter-se* priority attached to individual roads on an all-India basis, and fulfilment of the prescribed criteria for declaring new National Highways etc. It is, therefore, too early to indicate any details at this point of time.

Burmese M.Ps In India

ber of Burmese M.Ps, have been
camping in Mizoram;

(b) if so, how many and for how
long;

(c) whether Burmese students have made a
direct appeal to India to help to restore
democracy in their country; and

(d) if so, the attitude of Government in
this regard?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE
MINISTRY OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS
(SHRI EDUARDO FALEIRO): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) Three M.Ps. from Myanmar
namely Dr. Tint Shwe and U Than
Sein of the National League for Demo-
cracy (NLD), and Dr. Zahlei Thang
of the Chin National League for De-
mocracy (CNLD), arrived in India in
December, 1990. One more M.P. U
Li an Uk of United Nationalities Lea-
gue for Democracy (UNLD), entered
India in June 1991. All the four M.P.s
have since their arrival been staying
in camps in Aizawl (Mizoram).

(c) Yes, Sir.

(d) Government's sympathy and mora-
l support for the democratic movement in
Myanmar is well known.¹ However, consistent
with our well-established policy, we have
refrained from any actions which may be con-
strued as interference in Myanmar's internal
affairs.
