THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SMT. D. K. THARA DEVI SIDDHARTHA): (a) This Ministry is not aware of hospital organisations shelving plans to import Cobalt Therapy Units due to Reserve Bank of India's decision.

(b) Under the National Cancer Control Programme, there is a Scheme under which financial assistance to the extent of Rs. 20.00 lakhs is provided to medical institutions for installation of Cobalt Therapy Units, subject to availability of funds and fulfilment of necessary conditions.

Heart Patients being fleeced in AIIMS

(a) whether Government's attention has been drawn to a news-item that appeared in 'Indian Express', New Delhi of August 7, 1991 according to which heart patients are being fleeced by staff in All India Institute of Medical Sciences;

(b) whether any enquiry in this regard has been held; and

(c) if so, the details thereof and the outcome thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SMT. D. K. THARA DEVI SIDDHARTHA): (a) Yes, Sir. It has, however, been reported by AIIMS that only certain irregu-

larities in the maintenance of accounts of the amounts received from patients coming for heart operations have come to their notice.

(b) and (c) An enquiry has been ordered by the Institute and the same is in progress.

Export of high quality Iron Ore

(a) whether Government have planned to review the five year agreement between India and Japan for export of high quality Iron Ore produced by NMDC owned by Bailadila mines in Madhya Pradesh;

(c) whether Government also plans to stop exporting raw materials?

THE MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) OF THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE (SHRI P. CHIDAMBARAM): (a) and (b) The agreement with Japan for export of iron ore from Bailadila already contains provisions for reviewing and deciding the yearly quantities to be exported at the time of annual price negotiations;

(c) No, Sir. However, the Government's policy has been to encourage export of value added products in preference to export of raw materials.
