## Short Distance Mobile Telephone Services

- (a) whether the Department of Telecommunication (DoT) has decided to accept the Telecom Regulatory Authority of India's (TRAI) recommendations allowing basic telecom operators to offer short-distance mobile telephone services based on Wireless in Local Loop (WILL) technology; and

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI TAPAN SIKDAR): (a) TRAI's recommendation has been accepted for allowing the usage of hand-held telephone sets to subscribers of Basic Telephone Service within the local areas typically Tehsils on Wireless Access Systems.

(b) Domain of above permission for Basic Teledphone Service, is clearly different from that of the GSM based Cellular Mobile Telephone Service. No airtime charges are levied as tariff on subscribers utilizing the facility in (a) above.
