THE LEADER OF THE OPPOSITION (SHRI P. SHIV SHANKER): Madam,....

SHRI KAHNU CHARAN LE-NKA (Orissa): Madam, I have been waiting to make my personal explanation.

THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN: Mr. Lenka, I will allow you to make your personal explanation. It is just before me.

Madam, before the outset, at give my explanation, humility I would like to submit in all the Members this House to who listen to what I are present to going to say about the events that have taken place and I invite the opinion of all the Members on to restore the prestige of a Member of this House.

Madam, on the 9th May, 1990. at about 7-30 A. M., when I was coming out of my residence for catching the flight to Delhi to attend Parliament, a Special Vigilance Squad of the State Government reached my house and prevented me from going out and presented a paper as search warrant for my signature. They immediately started surrounding my house. Policemen surrounded my house and then they began to search. My children were unaware of this position and hence all our programmes were upset. They did not allow anybody to go out and searched the house as a result of which my family members were haras - " sed.
