

{b) 'whether Government' are aware that the annual report of that organisation, has printed a map of India without Kashmir; and-

(c) if so, what steps Government propose to take in this regard?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI SUBODH KANT SAHAY):

(a) No, Sir. There was no blanket ban on the entry into India of Members of the Amnesty International. However, the Indian Missions abroad were not empowered to grant visas to them and their applications were to be forwarded to the Ministry of Home Affairs by the Missions which were to be considered on merits. Now powers have been delegated to the Indian Missions to grant visas to the members, of Amnesty International for private visits and also for normal dialogue with Government. In all other cases, the applications are to be referred to the Ministry of Home Affairs for consideration.

(b) The 1990 report of the Amnesty International carries a small map of India which incorrectly depicts the International border between India and Pakistan.

(c) The matter is being taken up with the Amnesty International.

Persons killed in Cross-Firing in J&K
