डा० रत्नाकर पाण्डेय : माननीय सभापति जी जो विदेश, पर्यटन क्षेत्र हैं उनमें अण्णवित्त प्रदेश, तामिलनाडु मणिपुर, मिजोरम, सिक्किम, उत्तर प्रदेश और हिमाचल प्रदेश के कुछ भागों आदि का जवाब है। मैं मंत्र महोदय से जानना चाहता हूँ कि आपके द्वारा इ क्षेत्रों को निषिद्ध घोषित किए जाने के बाद इन क्षेत्रों में कितने विदेशी लोग आपके नियंत्रण में उल्लंघन करके आए हैं ?

श्री सुबोधकांत सहाय : अध्यक्ष महोदय, इसका जानकारी अभी पूरी तरह से उपलब्ध नहीं है।

डा० रत्नाकर पाण्डेय : आप तैयार होकर नहीं आए हैं। सदन में तैयार होकर आना चाहिए। इसकी जानकारी मुझे निवेदन में दी जाए।

SHRIMATI MARGARET ALVA: Sir, I want to ask the hon. Minister whether it is a fact that a number of foreigners whose passports have been impounded in the past have recently been allowed to come into India from abroad and have visited various places in the Punjab and, in fact, one of them came to India without the passport with your High Commissioner from London and was allowed to go all round the Punjab on his specific intervention. And how many such cases of foreigners without passports having been permitted to enter India have come to the notice of the Home Minister?

SHRI I. K. GUJRAL: Sir, I strongly refute the allegation that somebody came here without a passport.

SHRIMATI MARGARET ALVA: Sir, I will write to the Minister giving the details of the date, the name of the person and the places he visited in Punjab •without a passport.

SHRI I. K. GUJRAL: Yes, I confirm! the places he visited. But it is a wrong allegation that he is without passport and without permission.

- MR. CHAIRMAN; Question Hour is over.

SHRIMATI MARGARET ALVA: I raised it last week. But even the Foreign Minister did not deny when I raised it.

MR. CHAIRMAN: But now he is denying it.

MR. CHAIRMAN: He came separately.

. New National Highways in Gujarat

*385. SHRI ANANTRAY DEVSHANKER DAVE:

SHRI CHHOTUBHAI PATEL:

Will the Minister of SURFACE TRANSPORT be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government have received certain proposals for new National Highways in Gujarat; if so, which roads are proposed to, be declared as National Highways in Gujarat during the 8th Five Year Plan; and

(b) whether Government propose to make the Ahmedabad—Kajkot road as a four-lane one; if so, by when the project would be finalised?

THE MINISTER OF SURFACE TRANSPORT (SHRI K. P. UNNIKRISHNAN): (a) Yes Sir. Since the 8th Plant is not yet finalised, it is too early to say when any of the roads proposed might be declared as National -Highways..

• (b) No, Sir. However, a length of 15.8 Km of this road is already 4-lanes or being developed to 4-lanes, and 4-laning of another 1.2 km is included in the Annual Plan of 1990-91.

loss of Jobs and Properties by the Indians Returning from Iraq and Kuwait

*390. PROF. SOURENDRA BHATH TACHARJEE: Will the Minister of EXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether a large number of Indians "are still held up in" Kuwait and Iraq;

(b) whether it is a fact that those who have returned here have become jobless -and that their property abroad are in

danger of confiscation or wrongful possession;

(c) if so, the details thereof; and

(d) the action being taken in the matter on an urgent basis?

THE MINISTER OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI I. K. GUJRAL): (a) Before the current hostilities number of Indians in Kuwait and Iraq was estimated to be 1,72,000 and 9,000 respectively. A large number of these Indian nationals •are still in Kuwait and Iraq.

- (b) to (d) Government are not aware of any decision by the local authorities in Kuwait and Iraq to render those who have come back jobless or to confiscate their properties¹. However, Government are conscious that a large scale scheme of rehabilitation is likely to become necessary. In the view of Government, this "will have" to be part of a national effort involving the Central and State Governments, and other governmental and non-governmental agencies.
