Multilateral Cooperation among SAARC and NAM countries on Information Technology

@@3384-C. SHRI SIKANDER BAKHT: Will the Minister of EXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government have explored the possibility of multilateral cooperation among SAARC and NAM countries in the area of developing information technology in the native languages; if so, the details thereof;

(b) if not, the reasons of ignoring such a cooperative venture; and

(c) what is the time-bound strategy for initiating multilateral cooperation in electronics among developing countries?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI HARI KISHORE SINGH): (a) India took the initiative in October 1988 to convene an inter-governmental Consultative Meeting of Experts from Non-aligned and developing countries on¹ New and High Technologies, including Information Technology. Some SAARC countries were represented in the meeting. Some suggestions from this meeting have been incorporated into the work programme of the NAM Science and Technology Centre.
