**Clearance to ONGC for processing natural gas in East Godavari district Andhra Pradesh**

24. SHRI TALARI MANOHAR; Will the Minister of ENVIRONMENT AND FORESTS be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government have given environment clearance to ONGC to the process station for processing 2.5 million cubic meters of natural gas a day at Tatipala in East Godavari District of Andhra Pradesh; and

(b) if so, the details in this regard?

THE' MINISTER OF ENVIRONMENT- AND FORESTS- (SHRI NILAMANI ROURAY): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) The project envisages collection of gas through pipelines from nearby oil/gas wells and after processing, supplying it to industrial consumers. The proposal was examined and the proposed operations will not adversely affect the environmental quality. Adequate outlay have been provided towards capital and recurring expenditure for environmental protection and control.

**Misuse of funds<sup>oi</sup> Adult Education Programme in Andhra Pradesh**

25. SHRI TALARI MANOHAR: Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government are aware of the fact that the funds allocated for implementing Adult Education Programmes are being misused in Andhra Pradesh; and

(b) if so, what are the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI CHIMANBHAI MEHTA): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) (i) No misuse 'of funds has been reported in any Government run Adult Education Programmes'.

(ii) During evaluation of Voluntary agencies conducted by a Joint Evaluation<sup>Team</sup> consisting of a representative of Government of India, a representative of State Government and a non-official member, only one case of misuse of funds was reported. The State Government also has reported yet another case of misuse of a portion of funds released as grants to a voluntary agency. The total amount misused in both these cases is Rs. 95,360/-.

**Farm industrial and population growth rates during Seventh Five Year Plan**

26. SHRI TALARI MANOHAR; Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state what are the growth rates of agricultural and industrial output and of population during the Seventh Five Year Plan, State-wise and year-wise?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PLANNING AND THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PROGRAMME IMPLEMENTATION (SHRI BHAGEY GOBARDHAN): The indices of agricultural and industrial output are prepared by the Central Government only at the all India level. As such the Statewise growth rates of agricultural and

industrial output are not available. However, state-wise growth rate net value added from agriculture and manufacturing industry as also of population for available years of the Seventh Five Year Plan are given in the annexed statement. [See Appendix CLV, Annexure No. 3.]

(a) what is the total number of primary and secondary schools in the country and what is the number where there are no proper buildings, black boards, lavatories and drinking water facilities; State-wise; and
