Khanna Committee Report on Railway Safety

705. DR. C. NARAYANA REDDY: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(c) what are the reasons for the delay in implementing the Khanna Committee Report on Railway Safety;

(d) what is the plan of action for repairing or reconstructing a century old railway bridges; and

(e) what are the financial implications involved?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI O. RAJAGOPAL): (a) to (c) Action to implement accepted recommendations of Part-I of the Report of Railway Safety Review Committee-98 (Khanna Committee) has already been initiated. In order to implement one of the recommendations of Khanna Committee Report, a non-lapsable Special Railway Safety Fund of Rs. 17,000 Crores has been set up to wipe out arrears in renewal of over-aged assets within a fixed time frame of 6 years. Over-aged assets that are to be renewed also include Bridges.

Besides these, there are number of other recommendations having financial repercussions. These are being implemented progressively depending upon availability of funds and resources.
