#### Problem Villages in Bihar

\*434. SHRI DIGVIJAY SINGH : Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state :

(a) the number of villages in Bihar without drinking water facilities as on date; and

(b) whether any comprehensive scheme has been drawn up/is being implemented to provide drinking water to such villages?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI UPENDRA NATH VERMA) : (a) There were 34 no source category problem villages in Bihar without drinking water facilities as on 30th June, 1990.

(b) All the residual 34 problem villages are likely to be covered with safe drinking water facilities by 31-3-91 under the Centrally Sponsored Accelerated Rural Water Supply Programme and the State Sector Minimum Needs Programme.
