Irrigation schemes in Himachal Pradesh

337. SHRI KRISHAN LAL SHARMA: Will the Minister of WATER RESOURCES be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government's attention has been drawn to the news-item captioned 'H.P. irrigation schemes under neglect' which appeared in the Indian Express of 6th June, 1990;

(b) if so, what are the reasons therefor; and

(c) what action Government have taken in the matter?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF WATER RESOURCES (SHRI MANUBHAI KOTADIA): (a) to (c) Minor Irrigation scheme are planned, designed and implemented by the State Government and do not require clearance or sanction from the Central Government. As such, the comments of the State Government were asked. It has been stated that State Government is already aware of problems/short-comings mentioned in the news item and are taking necessary measures in this respect.

Incidents of gold smuggling

(c) what steps are being taken to check gold smuggling?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRI ANIL SHASTRI): (a) and (b) The number of seizures effected, the value of contraband seized, the value and quantity of gold seized and the number of persons arrested during the period from January to June, 1990 are given in the table below:

Number of Seizures : effected	Rs. 25,835
Value of seizures	: Rs. 315.22 crores.
Value of gold seized	: Rs. 86.55 crores.
Quantity of gold seized	2566 Kgs.
Number of persons arrested	1524
