Child Marriage and Dowry Deaths

1112. SHRI M. VINCENT Will the Minister of WELFARE be pleased to state:

(a) -whether it is a fact that child marriage and dowry deaths are increasing in the country because of illiteracy of women; and

(b) if so, what steps are proposed to be taken by Government to rectify these problems?

THE! DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE DEPARTMENT OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT IN THE MINISTRY OF WELFARE (SHRI-MATI USHA SINGH): (a) and (b) There are economic and social reasons for child marriages and dowry deaths and illiteracy of women is one of them the Government has issued instructions to the State Governments for effective implementation of the Child Marriage Restraint Act 1929 and the Dowry Prohibition Act 1986. However, to educate the public about the evil consequences of child marriages and the practice of dowry, various media and awareness genera-

tion programmes are held; innovative schemes for promoting women's empowerment like Mahila Samakhya programme are being implemented. Non-formal education and adult education programmes focussing on women have been taken up. Schemes for generating awareness amongst women about their rights are also being implemented by the Government..
