Under-Utilisation of STD and ISD systems during Non-Peak hours

1754. SHRI MENTAY PADMANABHAM: Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that STD and ISD system is under-utilised at certain non-peak hours in the country;

(b) what steps Government propose to take to grant further concessions at the late hours for STD calls; and

(c) whether Government would consider ways of assisting middle income people to use STD facility through lower rates for non-peak and office hours?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI JANESHWAR MISHRA): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) Concessions already exist for NSD calls. No further concessions are under consideration.

(c) No further concessions are under consideration. During non-peak hours concessions upto 75 per cent for NSD calls are already available.

(a) what is the city-wise present waiting list of telephone connections in the country;

(b) the name of the city which has largest waiting list of telephone connections; and

(c) by when telephones would be easily available in all parts of the country?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI JANESHWAR MISHRA): (a) Waiting list as on 31-3-90 of Telephone connections city-wise (1981 Census) in the country is enclosed in Annexure.

(b) Delhi metropolitan city is having largest waiting list in the country.

(c) The objective of the draft 8th plan is to provide telephones on demand in exchanges of capacities below 5000 lines and to contain waiting list to one year in exchanges having a capacity of 5000 lines and above by the end of the Eighth Plan on the basis of present demand projections. With this objective, expansion plans are being drawn for clearing the present waiting list progressively during the 8th Plan period.
