Reduction of Official Control on Exporters

1895. SHRI SANTOSH BAGRODIA : Will the Minister of COMMERCE be pleased to state :

(a) whether he has recently expressed an opinion to the effect that the share of world trade of India will not increase unless official control on exporters are drastically reduced ; and

(b) if so, what effective steps Government propose to take in this direction ?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE (SHRI ARANGIL SREEDHARAN) : (a) and (b) Government is of the view that simplification and deregulation should be undertaken progressively to increase the tempo of economic activity including exports. Recently, several measures have been taken to simplify export policy and procedure. Bank guarantee for export of ceiling items has been dispensed with to provide substantial procedural relief to the exporters. Powers have been delegated for the first time to the Regional Office for revalidating the export licences relating to ceiling items. The Constitution, function and the methodology adopted by Export Licensing Committee at Head-

quarters for clearing applications has been defined in the export policy for the first time. Procedure for export of goods for exhibition purpose has been simplified to facilitate better marketing of Indian merchandise abroad. The exporters of Machinery and equipments have been allowed to export spares on more liberal basis.
