

(b) if so, the main objectives thereof and the amount spent on this project;

(c) whether this project was implemented in Tamil Nadu and if so, the details thereof and the areas where the project was implemented;

(d) if answer to part (c) above be in the negative, the reasons therefor; and

(e) whether such projects are being implemented during the Eighth Five Year Plan and if So, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND COOPERATION IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI NITISH KUMAR): (a) and (b) A pilot project on rice was taken up during 1984-85 in selected blocks in Assam, Bihar, Eastern Uttar Pradesh, Eastern Madhya Pradesh, Orissa and West Bengal as a fore-runner to the main project with the objective to identify the constraints to higher rice productivity and production. An outlay of Rs. 500. 06 lakh was provided for implementation of pilot project on rice.

(c) and (d) The pilot project was not implemented in Tamil Nadu as the objective of the project was to identify the constraints in rice production in low rice productivity States. However, during 1988-89 and 1989-90 a Centrally Sponsored Special Foodgrains Production Programme—Rice was implemented in 8 selected districts of Tamil Nadu viz: Chengal-pattu, South Arcot, North Arcot, Tiruchi-rapalli, Thanjavur, Tirunelveli, Pudukot-tui and Madurai.

(e) A Centrally Sponsored Scheme "Integrated Programme for Rice Development" is being implemented during 1990-91 in 19 rice growing States including Tamil Nadu. The districts covered under the scheme in Tamil Nadu are the 8 above mentioned districts and Ramana-thapuram. The scheme is being implemented on 75: 25 funding pattern to be shared between the Government of India and the concerned States. Rs. 87 crores have been¹ provided as Central Share for implementation of the scheme during 1990-91.

Dairy Science College in Assam
