

(i) Plan scheme of an Integrated Programme for Older persons, and (ii) Non-Plan Scheme of Assistance to Panchayati Raj Institutions/Voluntary Organisations/Self Help Groups for construction of Old Age Homes/Multi Service Centres for Older Persons.

(b) The year wise financial assistance given to the Non Governmental Organizations in the State of Andhra Pradesh is Rs. 197.98 lakhs, Rs. 310.69 lakhs and Rs. 341.29 lakhs for the year 1998-99, 1999-2000 and 2000-2001 respectively.

(c) Total number of 133 non-governmental organizations of Andhra Pradesh have been assisted so far for 173 projects of old age homes, day care centres, mobile medicare units and non institutional service centres.

(c) and (d) Yes. Their details are maintained by the State Governments.

(e) The financial assistance provided to each state during the last five years is given in statement-II and III. (*See below*)

The financial assistance to be provided during the next ten years would depend on Budget available.

(f) The Government give financial assistance through Plan and Non-Plan Schemes.
