THE MINISTER OF ENERGY WITH ADDITIONAL CHARGE OF THE MINISTRY OF CIVIL AVIATION (SHRI ARIF MOHD. KHAN): (a) The. instructions have been issued to all States/ UTs to ensure that soft drinks and other food products manufactured and marketed in the country after 15-4-1990 are free from B. V. O.
