

CESSING INDUSTRIES (SHRI SHARAD YADAV): The industries coming under the purview of the Ministry of Food Processing Industries are those listed in item No. 27 of the first schedule of the Industries (Development & Regulation) Act and also non-molasses based alcohol and beer. Various agricultural products such as rice, wheat, fruits and vegetables, milk meat & fish etc. are utilised for processing.

Most of the food processing industries are delicensed. Food Processing Industries are in the organised, unorganised and cooperative sectors.

Maintenance of stock registers in the field Administrative Cell of CWTs in U.P. and Bihar
