1096. SHRI B. L. PANWAR: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether tecmio-economic survey of new gauga conversion project between Lalgarh-Merta Road (177 km) has been completed;

(b) the total estimate of this project;

(c) whether the conversion work has been commissioned and the amount spent so far; and

(d) by when this work is likely to be completed ?

THE MINISTER OF RAILWAYS (SHRI GEORGE FERNANDES): (a) Yes, Sir. Field work of Final Location Engineering-cum-Traffic Survey has been completed.

(b) The budget cost for Lalgarh-Merta Road section is Rs. 126.7 crores.

(c) No, Sir. The work has been approved to be taken up only in the 1990-91 Budget.

(d) Depends on availability of funds in the coming years.

**Gauge conversion project between—Viramgam**  
**Jodhpur**

(a) whether techno-economic survey of new gauge conversion project between viramgam-Jodhpur (436 Km.) has been completed;

(b) the total estimates of this project;

THE MINISTER OF RAILWAYS (SHRI GEORGE FERNANDES) :

(a) Final location surveys are in progress both on Northern and Western Railways.

(b) Rs. 424.49 crores approximately based on preliminary estimates.

(c) and (d) Conversion work is proposed to be taken up during this year. A sum of Rs. 19 crores has been allocated in 1990-91 Budget. Completion will depend on availability of resources in coming years.

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FOOD AND CIVIL SUPPLIES (SHRI RAM PUJAN PATEL) : (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) and (c) The Central Warehousing Corporation had reported that public sector fertiliser companies were hiring capacity from private agencies. The matter was taken up with Ministry of Chemicals and Fertilisers which reported that except for one company, which was utilising its own storage depots, the remaining fertiliser companies in publicand co-operative sectors were utilising Central Warehousing Corporation state Warehousing Corporations' and institutional agencies godown space between 52 to 100% lor storage of their fertilizer material. The Central Warehousing Corporation has been advised to discuss the matter further with fertilizer companies.
