- (a) what are the recommedations of the Bhujanga Rao Committee re garding introduction of new elective subjects at plus two stage; and
- (b) whether it is a fact that all the subjects provided for in KVS are taught in all Kendriya Vidyalayas at all levels?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI CHIMANBHAI MEHTA); (a) The recommendations of the Committee are presented in the Statement (See below.)

(b) The subjects provided Kendriya Vialayas upto Class X are taught uniformally in all Kendri Vidyalayas. The subjects taught in XI & XII classes vary from Vidya laya to Vidyalaya depending on the streams opened, keeping in view the requirements.

# Recommendations of the Bhujanga Rao Committee

1. Art Education Visual and performing which includes (tausic) 229 RS-5

Physical Education may be offered as e'lejetive subjects at -j-2 stage

to Questions

- In view of the transferability of the parents and mobility of students it is recommended that subjects mentioned in (1) above may be offered at selected Kendriya Vidyalayas among a cluster, preferably where some hostel facilities are available.
- In view of recommendation (2) 3. above it will be essential to create the posts of PGT's in these subjects, i. e. Art Education and Physical Education.
- 4. The existing PETs and Art teachers and Music Teachers (Art Teacher Performing)' if otherwise qualified, may be considered for permissible promotion upto number of vacancies of PGTs in these posts. The rest o the posts may be filled by open selection.
- Existing Music Teachers (Art teachers performing) are in the scale of primary teachers. Now since Music will be part of Art Education (Performing art) and will be taught upto Clas<sub>s</sub> X as a compulsory subject, the Music Teachers should be in the scale of TGT.
- A<sub>s</sub> such the existing Music 6. teachers, if otherwise qualified for the cadre of TGT, may be considered for this scale. Music teacher (in the scale of TGT), if otherwise qualified, may further be considered for promotion/ selection for the post of PGT (Music), provided Music is offered at -J-2 stage as an elective subject in KVs.
- 7. Physical Education Teachers, Art Teachers, sUPW teachers and Music Teachers (Art teachers performing) may be considered for promotion through DPC for higher posts in other subjects if they acquired necessary qualifications.
