The recruits are selected irrespective of the areas to which they belong.

In order to fill up the large number of vacancies in the North-East Region, a special recruitment drive, on all-India level, was made in 1984 for exclusive service in the Region. As a result of special efforts, 51 posts of PGTs, 96 posts of TGTs and 110 posts of PRTs were filled up in 1984.

The Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan has been making constant efforts to fill up the posts of teachers in the Kendriya Vidyalayas in different areas including North-East Region every year as a part of its annual recruitment plan.
