THE MINISTER OF SURFACE TRANSPORT (SHRI K.P. UNNIKRISHNAN): (a) to (c) There is no Elum by-pass on National Highway No. -5. Presumably, the reference is to ELURU bypass situated about 63 Km. from Vijayawada on Vijaya-wada-Visakhapatnam Section of H. No. 5. The alignment for plan Eluru bypass with a length of about 97.38 Km. was approved by the Ministry in January, 1989. Subsequently, the land acquisition esti-atefor construction of the by-pass has been sanctioned for an estimated amount of Rs. 391.40 lakhs. The construction of by-pass will be taken up after acquisiton of the entire land by the State Government and inclusion of the work in the Eighth Plan which is yet to be finalised.
