

However, in 1987, a Non-Official Committee was constituted to screen/ scrutinise applications received from Sind freedom fighters. The Committee considered 72 cases. All these cases have since been disposed of. The details of these cases are given in the Annexure. (See Appendix CLIV, Annexure No. 106).

Amounts paid on advertisements through DAVP to all the dailies published from Tripura

(b) Advertisements are issued to newspapers keeping in view the Government policy, publicity requirements and availability of funds and payments are made on the basis of release of advertisements according to this Policy.
