RE. ATROCITIES AGAINST WOMEN

SHRI VITHALRAO MADHAVRAO JADHAV (Maharashtra): Madam, the same question was raised when the Deputy Chairman was in the Chair, about atrocities against women in Madhya Pradesh. Today also it has come in the press that in Delhi one poor lady has been the target of such atrocities. The Home Minister is very much here in this House. I want the Home Minister to make a statement.

THE VICE-CHAIRMAN (SHRIMATI JAYANTHI NATARAJAN): I can't allow this. Please... (Interruptions) ... Will you please take your seat? I am on my legs. Please sit down.

SHRI VITHALRAO MADHAVRAO JADHAV: I want the Home Minister to make a statement on this. ... (Interruptions)...

THE VICE-CHAIRMAN (SHRIMATI JAYANTHI NATARAJAN): Dr. Ahmed, whatever you have said has gone on record. The Home Minister is here and, so, he will look into it. ... (Interruptions)

THE VICE-CHAIRMAN (SHRIMATI JAYANTHI NATARAJAN): I am sorry, Mr. Ahluwalia, I can't allow you to speak about another Member. You cannot make an allegation against another Member of Parliament..... (Interruptions) I am sorry, I cannot allow you to make an allegation against another Member of Parliament. Please sit down. I can't allow an allegation against another Member of Parliament. It will not go on record..... (Interruptions) I am sorry. Please don't make any allegations about other Members of Parliament. It will not go on record. Kindly sit down. You cannot raise it in this House. It has nothing to do with any Member of this House. We are taking up the Constitution (Sixty-Fourth Amendment) Bill.
