RESOLUTION RE. NOMINATION OF RAJYA SABHA MEMBERS TO THE PARLIAMENTARY COMMITTEE TO REVIEW THE RATE OF DIVIDEND PAYABLE BY RAILWAYS TO GENERAL REVENUES.

THE MINISTER OF RAILWAYS (SHRI GEORGE FERNANDES): Madam, I beg to move:

"That this House concurs in the recommendation of the Lok Sabha that the Rajya Sabha do agree to the nomination by the Chairman of six members from the Rajya Sabha to the Parliamentary Committee to review the rate of dividend which is at present payable by the Railway undertaking to General Revenues as well as other ancillary matters in connection with Railway Finance vis-a-vis the General Finance and make recommendations thereon".

The question was put and the motion was adopted.

SHRIMATI JAYANTHI NATARA-JAN (Tamil Nadu): Madam, I asked for permission of the Chairman. I have a very important matter of breach of privilege against the hon. Home Minister, Mr. Mufti Mohammad Sayeed. I asked for permission from the Chairman, and he has given me permission. I have moved a very important matter of breach of privilege.

SHRI KAMAL MORARKA (Rajasthan): There are so many motions of breach of privilege. How is she getting precedence over others?

THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN: What I have to say let me say. We have the reply of the Prime Minister. Let me handle it properly. I will request you to be patient, please.

SHRIMATI JAYANTHI NATARA-JAN: Madam, I will not make a long speech provided they do not interrupt me. If they interrupt, I cannot sit down till I make my point. I am raising an important matter of breach of privilege. (Interruptions) I am raising it in the House today before the hon. Prime Minister begins his reply on the Motion of Thanks. The breach of privilege relates to non-disclosure and suppression of facts before this House regarding kidnapping of Dr. Rubaiya, by the Home Minister. (Interruptions)

Madam, let me finish.

THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN: The Chairman will examine it and allow. Until and unless Chairman gives permission, I cannot say anything on it. (Interruptions)

SHRI YASHWANT SINHA (Bihar): You should acide by the reply of the Chairman to it. (Interruptions)

SHRI KAMAL MORARKA: A breach of privilege cannot be discussed.

SHRI YASHWANT SINHA: This is a totally new procedure that is being adopted.

SHRIMATI JAYANTHI NATARA-JAN: The Chairman has allowed me.

THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN: The Chairman did not allow you to speak. (Interruptions)

SHRI SATYA PRAKASH MALA-VIYA (Uttar Pradesh): The Chairman never asked you speak here.

SHRIMATI JAYANTHI NATARA-JAN: Madam, let me set the record straight.

SHRIMATI JAYANTHI NATARA-JAN: Madam, permit me to set the record straight. I had gone to the Chairman this morning. (Interruptions) Am I not allowed to set the record straight? (Interruptions)Let me put the facts, Madam. I had been to the Chairman. I told him that this was a very important issue.

SHRI SATYA PRAKASH MALA-VIYA: Madam, I am on a point of order. (Interruptions)

THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN: I have told you, and I will repeat again if you like in Hindi or in English or any other language I know, that when the Chairman gives permission, I will allow you.

SHRIMATI JAYANTHI NATARA-JAN: Let me set the record straight?

THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN: What is the record?

SHRI YASHWANT SINHA: There is no record to be set straight. Where is the record?

SHRI KAMAL MORARKA: The record is straight.

THE LEADER OF THE HOUSE (SHRI M. S. GURUPADASWAMY): May I make a submission?

SHRIMATI JAYANTHI NATARA-JAN: What is it that they are so scared about?

SHRI M. S. GURUPADASWAMY: Madam Deputy Chairman, we are well aware of the conventions and rules of the House that when a notice of any breach of privilege is given, it is given to the Chairman. He has got to exercise his judgement in regard to that. But that motion of privilege is not at all mentioned in the House nor is the matter about which a motion is sent to the Chairman for approval, mentioned in the House.

SHRIMATI JAYANTHI NATARA-JAN: Madam, I want to set the record straight. They do not want we to set the record straight. I said the Home Minister is misleading the House. Now, I sit down, Madam.

उपसभापति: दुसरे हाउस की बात यहां पर न उठायें ।

Mr. Ahluwalia, please sit down. We cannot discuss anything about the other House. I cannot permit. (Interruptions) I am very sorry. You have nothing to do with it. (Interruptions) I will not allow anything about the Member of the other House and what they are doing (Interruptions) I have already said. You don't hear it. I said that when a Member of this House...(Interruptions) I asked the Secretariat to find out. It is for the Lok Sabha Secretariat and the Government to find. We only can feel concerned about it. That is all.

श्री सरेन्द्रजीत सिंह अहलुवालियाः ...(व्य-वधान)... जो उनका अपहरण हुआ है मैं सरकार से चाहता हूं कि सरकार उनका पता लगाये।

SHRI DARBARA SINGH (Punjab): I only want to say this much that the hon. Prime Minister is here. He represents both the Houses. He has come here to reply. It is all right. But I would like to know what has happened to that man, who is a Member of Parliament. Has he been abducted? Where is he? He should give information.

THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN: The

Prime Minister is here. I understand the concern of the Members of Parliament. (Interruptions) Please. When I am speaking, will you please keep quiet? When the Prime Minister is here. I can understand the concern of the Members about any Member of any House. We have discussed about the upharan of the Members of the Assembly in Andhra Pradesh. I had allowed it. I understand the anguish of the Members of Parliament. The Government will take action on it.

SHRI SURESH KALMADI Maharashtra): But we want to be informed.

THE PRIME MINISTER (SHRI VIS-HWANATH PRATAP SINGH): The Home Minister will make a statement in the House and share with the House whatever information he has.

SHRI SURESH KALMADI: At what time?

SHRI **VISHWANATH PRATAP** SINGH: The time will be fixed.

THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN: Now, Mr. Prime Minister, you are replying to the Motion of Thanks on the President's Address.

MOTION OF THANKS ON THE PRESI-DENT'S ADDRESS-Contd.

THE PRIME MINISTER (SHRI VIS-HWANATH PRATAP SINGH): Madam Deputy Chairman, first I thank the hon. Members for the valuable contribution they have made in this debate on the Motion of Thanks on the President's Address. I would try my best to answer the substantial points raised by them.

[Mr. Chairman in the Chair]

Shri S.B. Chavan, the hon. Member, had occupied most important offices. He said that this is indeed a mandate for change but not a mandate for this Government. Certainly, it is not a mandate for the Congress. It may not be a mandate for the Opposition and that mandate of the people in the process of formation of the Government has got fully reflected in the sense that by a wide spectrum of cooperation the Government is here on their support. But let me make it clear and that is one thing very significant, the support is based on issues. I think this is a very healthy tradition that is developing in the country. It is significant and its import should be understood. From personalised politics to issue-based politics is a process of the maturity of our political democracy.

SHRI S.S. AHLUWALIA (Bihar): What about your value-based politics? ...(Interruptions),...

SHRI **VISHWANATH PRATAP** SINGH: Hold on. The issues includevalues but if you have some other values in mind, then, Government does not stand for them.

SHRI PAWAN KUMAR BANSAL (Punjab): We have the treatment of Mr. Jethmalani by your partymen in mind.

HANSRAJ SHRI **BHARDWAJ** (Madhya Pradesh): Mr. Prime Minister, did you read the speech by one of your Ministers delivered here. If we also start speaking in the same tone, then, none of your Minister, will be able to sit in this House. ...(Interruptions)... What did Arif speak here? ...(Interruptions)...

SHRI DIPEN GHOSH (West Bengal): Sir, is he holding a threat?

VISHWANATH SHRI PRATAP SINGH: Sir, I want a ruling from the Chair. Am I to proceed in this debate like in a Question Hour, Answering every supplementary? I can proceed that way, or, after every sentence, if a question is put, I respond to that. Or broadly I would seek the indulgence of the House.
