THE MINISTER OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT (SHRI MURASOLI MARAN) : (a) and (b) There is no anomaly in the pay scales of the Junior Engineers in the Central Public Works Department. However, the demand of the Junior Engineers for a uniform pay scale is under consideration.

Increase in the supply of water in Delhi

432. CHOWDHRY HARI SINGH : Will the Minister of URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) whether any plans have been worked out for increasing the supply of water to the residence of Delhi; and

(b) if so, the details of the same and by when those are likely to be implemented ?

THE MINISTER OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT (SHRI MURASOLI MARAN) : (a) and (b) Delhi Water Supply and Sewage Disposal Undertaking has reported that it has planned taken several long term measures and short term measures scheduled for completion within the current years to increase the supply of drinking water in Delhi. Some of the measures are:—

Short term measures :

- (i) Construction of 180 MLD water treatment plant at Wazirabad. First phase already completed.
- (ii) Construction of 54 MLD Iron Removal Water Treatment Plant at Okhla.
- (iii) Construction of 5 rainwater wells in Alipur expected to yield about 67.50 MLD.

Long term measures :

- (i) Construction of second 450 MLD Water Treatment plant at Haiderpur (2 years).
- (ii) Construction of 180 MLD (40 MGD?) water treatment plant at Nangloi (2-3 years).
- (iii) Construction of 450 MLD water treatment plant at Gokulpuri in trans-Yamuna

Concessions and facilities to Neo-Buddhists
