Colliery in Raniganj**

(a) whether Government have decided to appoint a court of inquiry to go into the causes and circumstances of the Mahavir Colliery mishap in Raniganj in West Bengal during November, 1989 and also propose to enquire into the functioning on DG of Mines Safety;

(b) if so, by when a court of inquiry would be appointed and it would submit its report ;

(c) the number of persons died in the colliery mishap ; and

(d) what further measures Government have since taken to avoid recurrence of such colliery mishap in the country?

THE MINISTER OF LABOUR AND WELFARE (SHRI RAM VILAS PASWAN) : (a) and (b) A proposal to appoint a Court of Inquiry under Section 24 of the Mines Act, 1952 is under consideration of the Government.

(c) Six persons died in the mishap;

(d) Provisions for safety health and welfare of workers employed in the mines are contained in the Mines Act, 1952 and the Rules and the Regulations framed thereunder and these are reviewed from time

to time. Guidelines, where called for are also issued by the Director General of Mines Safety. As a result of the measures taken, the number of fatal accidents and fatalities have shown a decline in recent years.
