Preventive action in this regard includes increased surveilance ; activising watch & ward anange-ments ; putting up of fencing/ boundary walls ; accountability of the enforcement staff and their mobility for intensive patrolling, Under the instructions of the Lt, Governor of Delhi, a Control Room has also started functioning to facilitate prompt reporting of unauthorised construction/encroachment by the public.
