duction of foodgrains during 1987-88 and 1988-89 were 140,35 and 170.25 million tonnes respectively.

The final estimates of production of foodgrains for 1989-90 have not yet become due from the States. However, according to the present assessment, the production of total foodgrains is expected to be in the range of 170-173 million tonnes.

- (b) The steps being taken by Government to maintain appreciable growth rate of foodgrains production include:
  - (i) Expansion of area under high yielding varieties/hybrids of rice, wheat, maize, jowar and baira;
  - (ii) Minikit Programms of rice. maize and miliets, including Propagation of new technology:
- (iii) Special Foodgrains duction Programme (SFPP) of rice (including SRPP) wheat, maize, arhar and gram;
- (iv) National Pulses Development Programme;
- (v) Shallow Tubewells and Dugwells Programme in SFPP States under Assistance to Small and Marginal Farmers;
- (vi) National Watershed Development Programme for Rainfed Agriculture. 40 3
