(c) what are the conclusions drawn by Government on the reports and discussions these teams had in Switzerland?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF DEFENCE (DR. RAJA RAMANNA): (a) Investigating officials have visited Switzerland to enquire into this case on several occasions.
