CRPF personnel killed in Jammu and Kashmir

983. CHOWDHRY HARI SINGH: Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state what is the number of jawans of the Central Reserve Police Force killed, injured and kidnapped by the suspected terrorists in Jammu and Kashmir in the months of January and February, 1990?

THE MINISTER OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI MUFTI MOHA-MMED SAYEED): Two CRPF jawans were killed and 63 injured by the suspected terrorists in Jammu & Kashmir in the months of January and February, 1990. No CRPF jawan has been kidnapped during this period.

Anti-India statement by the President of Bangladesh

THE MINISTER OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI I. K. GUJ-RAL): (a) Yes, Sir. Government's attention has been drawn to statements to that effect attributed to President Ershad.

(b) Government has raised this matter with the Bangladesh Government. In a joint press conference during my visit to Bangladesh from 16—18 February, 1990, the Bangla-

desh Foreign Minister, in reply to a journalist's query, said that he did not think the President over said such a thing. He further said that the President had been quoted out of context.
